

**PHILIPPINE FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT
CALENDAR YEAR 2011**

Hereunder are the salient features of our Agency's accomplishments for the period in review:

I. ON THE OPERATION OF THE REGIONAL FISH PORT COMPLEXES AND MUNICIPAL FISH PORTS

- A. Pursuant to its mandate, PFDA sustained the operation of the eight (8) Regional Fish Port Complexes (RFPCs) and one (1) Municipal Fish Port (MFP).
- B. From January to December 2011, the total volume of fish unloaded at the various fish port complexes maintained by PFDA reached a total of 297,638 metric tons (mt). Of this total, 42% was handled by the Navotas Fish Port Complex (NFPC) while the remaining 58% was contributed by the other six (6) regional fish port complexes. There was no fish unloading in Camaligan Fish Port Complex (CFPC). On the other hand, total number of fishing and non-fishing vessel arrivals reached 48,621.
- C. Insofar as processing activity is concerned, 2,643 mt of fishery products were processed in Zamboanga, Camaligan, Davao and General Santos Fish Port Complexes. Moreover, the total volume of ice produced at five (5) RFPCs was recorded at 39,940 mt.
- D. Volume of fish unloaded and transshipped at Infanta Municipal Fish Port in Quezon reached 3,211 mt. On the other hand, commercial and municipal fishing vessel arrivals reached 1,386. To date, a total of seventy four (74) MFPs were turned-over to LGUs nationwide.

II. ON THE OPERATION OF THE ICE PLANT AND COLD STORAGE (IPCS) PROJECT

In line with the government's privatization scheme, PFDA leased out various ice plants and cold storages to the private sector. To date, there are eight (8) IPCS that were leased out nationwide.
